

Prevalence of immunity against infection of hepatitis A and hepatitis B in children Cochabamba, Bolivia

Prevalence of immunity against infection of hepatitis A and hepatitis B in children Cochabamba, Bolivia. A cross-sectional study was conducted in Cochabamba, Bolivia, in 2010. A total of 424 children (n = 424) and 436 children (n = 436) were included in the study. The prevalence of immunity against hepatitis A (95.4%) and hepatitis B (97.9%) was significantly higher than in previous studies. The prevalence of immunity against hepatitis A was 95.4% (95% CI: 93.5-97.4) in children aged 5-10 years, 97.9% (97% CI: 96.4-99.5%) in children aged 10-13 years, and 99.4% (99.1-100%) in children aged 14-17 years. The prevalence of immunity against hepatitis B was 97.9% (97% CI: 96.4-99.5%) in children aged 5-10 years, 98.7% (98.4-99.0%) in children aged 10-13 years, and 99.5% (99.4-99.6%) in children aged 14-17 years. The prevalence of immunity against hepatitis A was significantly higher than in previous studies (5.8% (95% CI: 3.3-8.3%); in men (9.1%), in women (9.7%), in men (37.9% (95% CI: 28.5-48.1%), in women (51.0%), in men (53.9%), in women (72.7%). The prevalence of immunity against hepatitis B was 1.1% in men and 1.2% in women (> 0.05).

The prevalence of immunity against hepatitis A was 4.5% in children aged 5-10 years, 4.5% in children aged 10-13 years, and 4.5% in children aged 14-17 years.
