An exploration of the value of Marte Meo therapy in improving resilience and attachment relationships between caregivers and their children

Aim: e purpose of this qualitative study was to explore the value of Marte Meo therapy in establishing, re-establishing and supporting attachment and resilient relationships between caregivers and their children. ese researches examined previous works on attachment theory and suggest ways in which the Marte Meo method may provide a practical application of this theory.
