## Exploring resilience among adolescents: analysis of three case vignettes

This paper explores the life journey of adolescents to comprehend the construct of resilience. e phenomenon of resilience was explored from three adolescents residing at a socially and economically deprived neighborhood of Janta Nagar, in Mumbai, India. A phenomenological approach was adopted to understand resilience as a subjective experience shaped to a shared identity of deprived adolescents. Purposive and snowball sampling was used to select participants. Focused gro discussions were held to investigate the risk conditions among adolescents of the community. In-depth interviews were conducted to collect data that elicited information on the subjective positive outcomes. e narratives of one female and two
