During action of the Kyoto Protocol, the GHG emissions are growing of about 52 billion tons per year or up 58% from 1990. The UNEP predicted that even if all countries deliver on the Paris Climate Agreement, the world will warm by 3.0 to 3.2°C. The UN's top Climate change officials, Addis Ababa Action Agenda and the Marrakech Partnership for Global Climate Action declare as imperative action multi-stakeholder partnerships and the attraction of the private sector investment for fast track development of climate change mitigation.
