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**Background & Aim :** Atypical parkinsonism, accounts for 0.2 to 1.5% of all cases with probable Parkinson's disease and its subtypes are Progressive Supranuclear Palsy (PSP); Multiple Systems Atrophy (MSA), Dementia with Lewy Bodies (DLB) and Cortico Basal Degeneration (CBD); they share clinical presentation and have a poor response to Levodopa.
