Colon polypectomy and endoscopic mucosal resection

About 70%–80% of colorectal neoplasia arises from conventional adenomatous polyps. Polypectomy reduced the risk of colorectal cancer by the order of 75%–90%. 80% to 90% of polyps are smaller than 10 mm. Morphological description (considering Paris classification), Size estimation (smaller or larger than 10 mm), Relation to the surrounding mucosa: (e.g. Saddle distribution over a fold, or an invasive lesion. Safe polypectomy implies the ability to resect and completely remove
