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Cirrhosis is a chronic progressive illness that affects 4.5% to 9.5% of the population, and an estimated 50 million adults worldwide. Alcohol, NASH and viral hepatitis are reported to be the most common causative factors. HCV is carried by an estimated 170 million people worldwide and approximately 3-4 million new cases occur a year. In 2001, cirrhosis ranked as the 14th and 10th
