Statement of the Problem: Postoperative ileus (POI) is a transient impairment of bowel motility following surgery. e etiology of POI is complex; it is primarily associated with the surgical stress response, an acute in ammatory response associated with manipulation and endogenous opioids secreted within the gastrointestinal tract in response to surgical trauma. e anesthetic management routines (e.g., opioid-sparing anesthesia and analgesia with epidural anesthesia and analgesia) that may response to the stress response.
