Background:Chronic musculoskeletal pain is o en associated with comorbidity, long-term disability and reduced quality of life. Current treatments only modestly reduce pain, disability, and distress. Homeopathy is increasingly used in pain conditions in general practice but scienti c evidence is lacking. We therefore designed a clinical trial in a way that would not change the practice pattern of homeopathic physicians. e purpose of the study was to explore e ects of an individualised homeopathy treatment on pain symptoms and quality of life of patients with chronic musculoskeletal pain.

Method:
