For novice scleral lens tters, this course will prepare them to initiate tting their patients with scleral lenses. For those who have scleral experience, it will also present special techniques/modi cations that make helpful in solving complex tting challenges that scleral lens wearers may present. e objective is to provide practitioners with detailed description of every step involved in tting and caring for patients wearing scleral lenses including: patient selection, pre- tting diagnostic evaluation of the patient, specialized testing, initial diagnostic lens selection and evaluation, lens ordering, follow-up care, modi cation of the t, problem-solving, speci c care and handling of lenses and in-o ce management tips. It is hoped that, upon completion of this course, practitioners will be comfortable with all aspects of tting and problem-solving with scleral lenses.
