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Statement of the Problem: Gastric diverticula (GD) are rare and frequently asymptomatic. However, there are cas that present with massive upper gastrointestinal bleeding (UGIB). A search by Gibbons et al., revealed only ve ca that have shown that intraluminal hemorrhage originated within the diverticulum. We report a 69-year-old female who presented at the emergency room (ER) with massive hematemesis. She had a three-month history of hearth epigastric discomfort and vomiting. She eventually developed acute respiratory failure secondary to hypovolem shock from UGIB. She was conscious and generally pale, with anicteric sclera and pale conjunctivae. Abdomi examination showed a midline infra-umbilical scar, but was otherwise unremarkable.

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
