### A quality improvement approach to reduce infections in neonatal intensive care

Outcomes in neonatology has improved dramatically in the last 3 decades Improved survival- associated with increasing short term and long term morbidity Infections- important cause of morbidity and mortality Majority of infections are potentially preventable Early onset sepsis related to maternal and perinatal factors

- · Accessibility of hand gel at bedside was an issue
- Turnover of new sta eg . Residents who were poorly

#### Oriented

- · Hand hygiene of parents not monitored or enforced
- Mobile phone use in the clinical area
- · Publicity poor
