Zucchini yellow mosaic virus (ZYMV) belonging to Potyvirus family is responsible for causing major crop losses in summer squash in India. By Direct Antigen Coating Enzyme-linked immunosorbent assay (DAC ELISA) the presence of potyvirus was confirmed in 70% of particles at 0, 1, 3, 5, 7, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, 100 days after infection. The results of the study are presented in Table 1.
