Euro surgery 2020. Acute Tip Appendicit s Contained within a Right Sided Hernia (Amyand's Hernia): A Case Report:

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Abstract: This pat ent may be a 64 year old male with a PMH of depression, anxiety, COPD, gastrits, and former right hernia repair who presented to the ER with one day t th s dat t is tender to palpat on [1]. On physical exam pat ent had a sof and non-tender abdomen. An exquisitely tender 2cm x 2cm palpable nodule in the right groin was noted.

Image Art de: This pat ent may be a 64 year old male with a PMH of depression, anxiety, COPD, gastrits, and former right hernia repair who presented to the ER with one day of right groin pain that occurred suddenly the night before. He has never experienced pain like this before and over the counter analgesics didn't relieve the pain. Pat ent states that the pain is associated with a small budge in the right groin that is tender to palpat on [1]. On physical exam pat ent had a sof and non-tender abdomen. An exquisitely tender 2 cm 2 cm palpable nodule in the right groin was noted. CT scan of the abdomen showed a right sided inguinal hernia containing the appendix with acute t p appendicit s. Inguinal hernias containing the appendix are rare and are ment oned as an Amyand hernia. These are usually found during

rout ne inguinal hernia repairs and are a curiosity for the operat ng surgeon, but there is lit le change in the operat ve management of an open hernia repair when the appendix is easily reducible. Rarer st II is the f nding of acute appendicit s contained within an inguinal hernia (Figure 1). This f nding complicates the management and as such is that case with acute a

In this case, the acute appendicits was the more pressing pathology. It was d dincd pppe gcu appendicits [3]. Due to the acute infammat on, the decision was made to not repair the hernia, and instructed the pat ent to return for follow-up where an elect ve inguinal hernia repair with mesh would be planned (Figure 2).
