

Adenocarcinoma Arising from Fistula in Ano

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Adenocarcinoma

Previously reported adenocarcinomas are of low grade in about 44% percent cases [12]. One of the study concluded the final management as abdominoperineal resection with wide tumor excision on the gluteal region and reconstruction by bilateral gracilis musculocutaneous flaps [13]. It is important to look for unusual changes like persistent discharge, gradually increasing perianal mass, bloody discharge, unusual healing or induration in case of perianal fistula. Biopsy should be taken in all cases to be on the safer side.

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
