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Abstract

The study addresses a health care model of the elderly pract ced by a health care provider in the city of Rio de Janeiro, RJ, Brazil, focusing on the age group of the elderly, populat on segment in which the greatest misconcept ons are ident f ed. The current assistance models did not consider the deep transformat ons observed in the new epidemiological and demographic reality of the country. Considering that the aging process in Brazil is relat vely recent, this study presents a proposal for a contemporary care model, recommended by the most important nat onal and internat onal health agencies as the most suitable for bet er care, focusing on the promot on, prevent on of health care and the coordinat on of care, in order to avoid excesses, waste and fragmentat on. The assistance and f nancial results of this study display very posit ve f gures and indicate the path to be taken by healthcare companies. To present the economic results used from the daims analysis of a chronic management program and its impact on sustainability, from a port olio of supplementary health dients over the last 4 years. Methodology - Descript ve study, type experience report. Loss data from June 2014 to July 2018 were analyzed. Results - This type of care that favors comprehensive care and prevent on through cont nuous monitoring of the health condit ons of members and coordinat on of care in all instances of care. at ent on, showed posit ve results in relat on to the reduct on of the customer port olio loss rat o, as we observed in the first year was 108.2%, in the second 85.4%, in the third 82.46% and in the fourth year 70.85%. Conclusions - These results demonstrate that clinical stabilizat on through cont nuous follow-up with a care navigator and referral physician contributed to a reduct on in consultat ons with specialists and unnecessary diagnost c tests, consequently leading to greater cost control of the operator.
