Crohn's disease (CD) and Intestinal tuberculosis (ITB) are both chronic inflammatory conditions of the gastrointestinal tract. The clinical presentation of both diseases is often overlapping, making the diagnosis challenging. Parametric predictive models have been developed to help differentiate between these two conditions based on clinical and laboratory data.
