Abstract

Traumatic tooth loss is a common incident in active children.

The mean prevalence of congenitally missing teeth was reported to be $6.53\% \pm 3.33\%$; and therefore, they make up the vastness of the developmental anomaly of the human dentition. While researches are extensively addressing every aspect related to implants in adults, a paucity of equivalent articles are tackling dental implants in growing children and adolescents.
