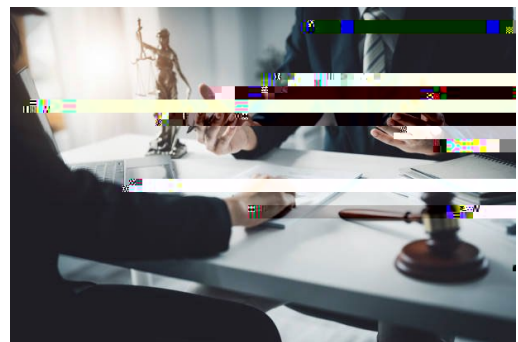


Figure 1: Knowledge of medieval Christian sources among the parochial clergy.

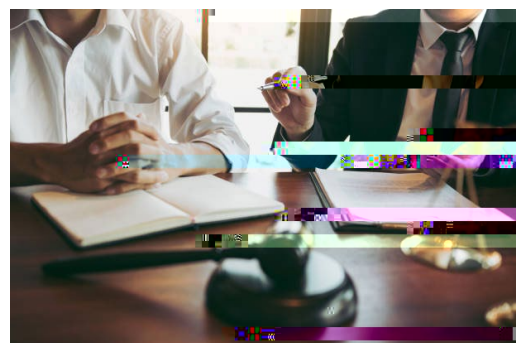


Figure 2: Preacher's point .

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
