## **Clinical Image**

Acute epiploic appendagitis is an uncommon cause of abdompain [1]. It is a rarely reported condition (1.3% of abdominal explored by CT) caused by spontaneous torsioner access nore epipappendages.

Epiploic appendages (EA) are small, pedunculated, move protrusions of fat located on the colonic wall and range in size f 0.5 to 5 cm. Although they can occasionally reach 15 cm in diam [2]. ey are found in the rectosigmoid junction (57%), ileocecal regions.
