e patient was a 45 years old man who came with chief complaints of gradual onset Progressive le nasal obstruction since one year. Patient had history of septoplasty operation done in same hospital 2 years back. Patient had history of recurrent common cold but no history of epistaxis. His Medical history was insigni cant. On anterior rhinoscopic examination, well-circumscribed mass was seen lling the le nasal cavity which probably aroused from the middle meatus [1-7]. We had done diagnostic nasal endoscopy in which the reddish mass seen in a le nostril almost touching originating from the le maxillary sinus (Figure 1). e right nasal cavity and nasopharynx appeared normal. e all routine investigation was within normal limits.
